## A Surprising Discovery on the One Millionth Corvette

Craftspeople and technicians at the GM Design Center are painstakingly restoring the historic 1 millionth Chevrolet Corvette, damaged February, 2014 when a sinkhole opened up in the Museum. The restoration crew is part of GM's Mechanical Assembly group, which typically spends its time building prototype and concept vehicles. The white 1992 Corvette is a challenge because rather than build an all-new vehicle from the ground up, the workers are trying to preserve the original appearance of a production vehicle.

"We got it back here and we started opening it up, and one of the cool things, we saw were all the signatures of the employees, they had signed individual parts as the vehicle was being built, and that's throughout the whole vehicle, inside of the fascias, the frame," said Ed Welburn, Vice President of Global Design. "You can kinda envision them doing that, because they didn't sign a complete vehicle, they signed it as it was being built. And we have to save those signatures."
